

How to enable the firewall on Olex.

Enter Maintenance at start up, or take the shortcut from Olex by: Ctrl + Shift + Right mouse click.

```
/home/olex% su
Password:
[root@olex olex]#
```

Point the mouse into the window. Become root by typing “su”, and the password: fiskebat

```
/home/olex% su
Password:
[root@olex olex]# system-config-firewall-tui
```

Open the firewall user interface by performing: system-config-firewall-tui

```
system-config-firewall

Use the Space key to enable the firewall

```

system-config-firewall
